GAËTANELLE GILQUIN is a Professor of English Language and Linguistics at UCLouvain. She specializes in corpus linguistics and learner corpus research. She has been involved in the compilation of several corpora, including the Louvain International Database of Spoken English Interlanguage (LINDSEI), the New Englishes Student Interviews corpus (NESSI) and the Process Corpus of English in Education (PROCEED), as well as their exploitation for theoretical, descriptive and pedagogical purposes.
